What is 14c and why does it matter?

Section 14c of the Fair Labor Standards Act allows employers to obtain special certificates to pay people with disabilities less than the federal minimum wage. This outdated law discriminates against people with disabilities and must be abolished.

Uniting for Change believes all people deserve to earn a living wage, or at the very least, earn minimum wage, for their work. Ending 14c certificates will ensure fairness and promote dignity and respect for every worker. Employers who hire people with disabilities at equitable pay gain access to a loyal, productive, and innovative workforce.



In Georgia, people with disabilities make as few as 22 cents per hour.
